The purpose of the Private Security Disciplinary Review Committee (DRC) is to review applicants' appeals of the Bureau of Security and Investigative Services' denials of licensure and licensees' appeals of the Bureau's suspensions and imposition of fines. The Private Security DRC is authorized to hear appeals of private proprietary security employers and officers, as registered by the Bureau under Chapter 11.4 (commencing with Section 7574 of the Business and Professions Code), and private patrol operators, private patrol operator qualified managers, security guards, firearm permit holders, firearm training facilities and instructors, and baton training facilities and instructors, licensed, certified, or registered by the Bureau under Chapter 11.5 (commencing with Section 7580 of the Business and Professions Code).
