The purpose of the Private Security Disciplinary Review Committee (DRC) is to review applicants' appeals of the Bureau's denials of licensure and licensees' appeals of the Bureau's suspensions and imposition of fines. Specifically, Business and Professions Code section 7581.2 states the DRC shall perform the following functions as they pertain to private patrol operators, security guards, firearm qualification permit holders, firearm training facilities and instructors, and baton training facilities and instructors licensed, certified, or registered by the Bureau under Chapter 11.5 (commencing with Section 7580), and private proprietary security officers, as registered by the Bureau under Chapter 11.4 (commencing with Section 7574):

- (a) Affirm, rescind, or modify all appealed initial Bureau decisions which concern administrative fines assessed by the director.
- (b) Affirm, rescind, or modify all appealed initial Bureau decisions which concern denials, citations or suspensions of a license, certificate, or registration except denials, or suspensions ordered by the director in accordance with Chapter 5 (commencing with Section 11500) of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code.
