

ALERT! Security Guard On-Line Licensing System Permanently To Be Shut Down on January 5th

The Bureau of Security & Investigative Services (BSIS) is scheduled to transition to BreEZe, the Department of Consumer Affairs' online licensing and enforcement system, in mid-January 2016. As part of the transition, on the morning of Tuesday January 5th, the current Security Guard On-line Licensing system will be shut down and permanently discontinued. The Bureau will accept security guard paper applications from January 5th to the date of the Bureau's transition to BreEZe. However, no paper applications will be processed during the couple of days before and after the BreEZe transition to allow for the successful transfer of data to BreEZe.

Security guards who have utilized the existing online licensing system and who want to use BreEZe for their future online licensing activities will need to establish a new user profile and password to access their license information through BreEZe. **NOTE: New BreEZe accounts can be established only after BSIS' transition to BreEZe in mid-January 2016.**
