ORDER OF ADOPTION

Amend Section 639 of Division 7 of Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations as follows:

§ 639. Private Investigator Fees.

The fees prescribed by ~~section~~ sections 7529 and 7570 of the Private Investigator Act are as follows:

(a) The application and examination fee for an original license shall be ~~fifty three hundred forty dollars (\$50340)~~ plus the fee for each required enhanced photo identification card as set forth in subdivision (i).

(b) The application fee for an original branch office certificate shall be thirty ninety dollars (~~\$3090~~).

(c) The fee for an original license for a private investigator shall be ~~one hundred seventy-five three hundred eighty-five~~ dollars (\$175385).

(d) The renewal fee is as follows:

(1) For a license as a private investigator, the fee shall be ~~one hundred twenty-five two hundred sixty-five~~ dollars (\$125265) plus the fee for each required enhanced photo identification card as set forth in subdivision (i).

~~(2) For a combination license as a private investigator and private patrol operator under Chapter 11.5 (commencing with Section 7580), AG or DC prefix, the fee shall be six hundred dollars (\$600).~~

~~(3)(2) For a branch office certificate for a private investigator, the fee shall be thirty sixty-five dollars (\$3065), and for a combination private investigator and private patrol operator under Chapter 11.5 (commencing with Section 7580), the fee shall be forty dollars (\$40).~~

(e) The fee for reexamination of an applicant or his or her manager shall be ~~fifteen~~ sixty dollars (~~\$1560~~).

(f) The fee for the assignment of a private investigator license shall be ~~one hundred twenty-five four hundred~~ dollars (\$125400).

(g) A firearms permit fee shall be one hundred dollars (\$100).

(h) A firearms permit renewal fee shall be eighty dollars (\$80).

(i) The "enhanced photo identification card fee" as provided in this section shall be four dollars (\$4) per card for each licensee including each individual, partner of a partnership, officer of a corporation, or member, manager, or officer of a limited liability company, and any qualified manager as defined in Section 7512.7 of the Code.
