



NOTICE OF NEW PROPOSED RULEMAKING REGARDING FEES

The Bureau of Security and Investigative Services (Bureau) proposes to amend sections 638, 639, 640, 641, 642, & 642.5 of Article 8 of Division 7, Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations (CCR).

The Bureau is seeking to amend the fees charged for locksmiths, private investigators, private security services, alarm company operators and agents, collateral recovery, and proprietary private security officers. These fee changes will apply to the following: application, examination, reexamination, original license and renewal, initial registration, employee initial registration, branch certificates, assignment processing, firearms permit and renewal, qualified manager certificate and renewal, initial baton permit and renewal, as well as delinquency and reinstatement fees.

This proposal is necessary to provide the Bureau with the resources required to maintain operations needed to prioritize consumer safety and protection, and to sustain the costs of administration and enforcement.
