Please be advised that the Bureau accepts only current license application forms. The Bureau routinely updates license applications to reflect changes in the law. Since the use of an outdated application form means the applicant is not providing all required information, the outdated application form is deficient. Outdated applications received will be sent back to the applicant with instructions to submit his or her application on a current application form.

Given that outdated applications impact the Bureau's ability to issue licenses timely, your cooperation is requested and appreciated.

The most current versions of applications and forms may be found on the BSIS website at http://www.bsis.ca.gov/forms_pubs/index.shtml. In regard to alarm agent, locksmith company employee, and repossession agency employee initial applications, the most current versions have a July 2015 revision date. Discard all unused applications with older revision dates.

Alarm companies, locksmith companies, and repossession agencies may request hard copy employee applications by submitting an email to the respective company email address. The request must include the company name and license number, phone number, and a point of contact. The Bureau will confirm the requester's authorization to receive the applications.

Individuals seeking an Alarm Agent or Locksmith Employee registration may either apply online through <u>BreEZe</u> or obtain a paper application from their employer or prospective employer.
